healthcare, ensuring timely treatment and preventive care for livestock. The



assessment application designed to enhance foundational literacy skills among students in India. This first of its kind literacy app has been developed by Dr. Radhika Misquitta and her team. The research based app is tailored to the Indian education system and is offered free of charge for primary grades. It covers English for grades 1-5, and Hindi and Marathi for grades 1-3. Currently 59 schools and 8,065 students nationwide have adopted and implemented the application. The Gateway Research and Outreach Cell's aim is to make FABLe accessible to all schools and educators across India, contributing to the nation's goal of ensuring foundational literacy for every learner. As The Gateway Research and Outreach Cell develops FABLe further, they are looking to partner with likeminded schools and organizations to develop intervention programs. To know
